As the President of Osooro Leaders of Thought, he played a pivotal role in fostering peace and unity between Ilutitun and Igbotako communities. Under his leadership, the long-standing disputes between these communities were resolved, creating a more harmonious and united Osooro. This remarkable initiative, brought together by the efforts of Prince Dr. General Oluyemi Bajowa CFR and Prince Donald Ajibola Morebise was a testament to his vision of a united community.

A highly cerebral man of letters, he had a profound love for literature, especially the works of Shakespeare. His ability to speak Latin fluently and quote classical texts set him apart as a scholar who valued knowledge and intellectual discourse. His wisdom and eloquence were respected by all who knew him, and he often shared his insights with a depth that resonated with both the young and the old. He was an encyclopedia of Ikale History who never failed to recount Ikale beaded crown history, the unity and determination of the founding fathers of Ilutitun Osooro before and after it was founded in 1920, Tax Agitation in ikaleland etc

Even in his later years, he remained industrious and entrepreneurial. He was actively engaged in various trades and he invested in property, owning a sprawling estate that became a symbol of his hard work and astute business acumen.

He was also a passionate political figure. As a founding member of the People's Democratic Party (PDP) in 1999, he remained politically active and interested in Developmental Politics until his final days, always staying abreast of the political dynamics of the nation and advocating for good governance.
